TUITION and FEE SCHEDULE 2010-2011

Please follow the payment plan below for each month. ACS is a non-profit organization. We receive no county, state, or federal funds. Our tuition is 75% of the average tuition for schools in our area, and no other school has multi-family discounts like ACS.

Based on input from parents, starting with the 2010-2011 school year, we are using a tuition management system. This will allow you to choose your payment methods, have instant access to payments, choose your payment schedule, and keep up with all fees in one place. **Please note, the first tuition payment is due June, 2010 for all payment plans. Schedule shows 12 payment plan using ACH autodraft payments. Monthly invoice billing adds \$10/month per family. A 2.5% convenience fee applies to credit card payments. 2% discount for tuition or fees paid in full with 1 payment.**

Family Tuition: Family tuition is calculated from the oldest student in the family to the youngest. The third student in the family is charged one-half tuition and no further tuition applies for more than 3 students; however, there will be a \$432/year charge (payable with tuition over 12 months) for each student above the 3rd student to cover book/participation/consumable material fees.

Technology Fee: ACS has implemented a new website, online grades, online tuition/billing, and added many computer services school wide. Starting this year, a \$75 per family technology fee will be collected to cover these and other improvements to benefit our families and students. This is payable June, 2010.

Trips: Accounts must be in good standing with the Business Office for School Trip participation.

Late Fees: All tuition and fee payments are subject to a \$25 per incident late fee. Overdraft/return payment fees may also apply.

Lunch, Bus, Extended Care and Study Hall: The first payment for lunch, bus, Extended Care and Study Hall is due by **August 1**. Every month thereafter fees are due by the 1st of the month beginning August 1 and ending April 1. There are **nine** fee payments per year. If lunch and bus fees are paid each month for 9 months (August 1-April 1) there will be no May payment. However, the May 1 payment will be due, if you are not a full-year participant, and you choose to use these services in May.

Lunch Fees: These fees have not changed for this year. We offer a monthly lunch plan; however, if a student is not on a monthly plan, and needs lunch for a particular day, the fee is \$5.00 (not catered) (Grades 1-12). Beverage by the day is \$1.50. Cafeteria services are on a prepaid basis. Student ID cards are required for lunch services.

Bus Fees: Bus fees are **\$79/month**. Only the first two students in a family pay monthly bus fees. If someone is not a regular bus rider, but they would need this service to help them in an emergency, the fee is \$5.00.

Student IDs: Students in K-12 will be given ID's that serve as free passes to all home athletic events. \$5 charge to replace lost card.
