

**ATHENS CHRISTIAN SCHOOL
TUITION and FEE SCHEDULE 2008-2009**

Please follow the payment plan below for each month. If you wish, payments can be paid for the year at the beginning of school. ACS is a non-profit organization. We receive no county, state, or federal funds. *The cost for Clarke County to educate a student in public education for 1 year is \$9,600.* Therefore, I think that we will all agree that ACS tuition is a great bargain. We are trying to do our best to keep all tuition and fees as low as possible. All tuition, lunch, and bus fees will receive a 2% discount, if paid in full for the school year by August 1, 2008.

Family Tuition: Family tuition will be calculated from the oldest student in the family to the youngest in the family. The third student in the family is charged one-half tuition. There is no tuition fee for any additional student in the family.

Late Fee and Returned Check Fee: For all tuition payments received after the 15th of the month, a \$20.00 late charge will be added to cover additional bookkeeping, unless other arrangements were made in advance. The fee for returned checks is \$25.00 per check.

Lunch, Bus, and other Fees: The first payment is due by August 1. Every month thereafter fees are due by the 1st of the month beginning August 1 and ending April 1. There are nine fee payments per year. If lunch and bus fees are paid each month for 9 months (August 1-April 1) there will be no May payment. However, the May 1 payment will be due, if you are not a full-year participant, and you choose to use these services in May.

Morning Milk Break: Students in grades K3 – 2nd may purchase milk for break for \$18 per month.

Bus Fees: Only the first two students in a family pay bus fees. The others are free. If someone is not a regular bus rider, but they would need this service to help them in an emergency, the fee is \$5.00.

Lunch Fees: We offer a monthly lunch plan, however, if a student is not on a monthly plan, and needs lunch for a particular day, the fee is \$5.00 (Grades K-12). Beverage by the day is \$1.50. Cafeteria services are on a prepaid basis.

The book fee includes consumable books, the usage of textbooks and lab equipment, achievement testing, paper fee, computer fee, music classes; GACS, AACS, & GHSA membership fees. **The book fee for grades 5-12 includes the Participation Fee**, which covers participation in auxiliary units, Bible Quiz, cheerleading, band, chorus, and all sports. Students in grades K-12 will be given ID's that will serve as free passes to all home athletic events.
